

Hospitality: We will not be offering food. Muffins and bottled water will be offered. Please supply your own food. McDonald's is in Spring Arbor, across the street from the Church, for food and restroom facilities. There also is a gas station in Concord with Subway.

ENTRY FEES (in U.S. Funds) TDX-\$120 (includes AKC fees). An AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 and an AKC Recording Fee of \$0.50 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This fee is to be collected by the trial-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. American Kennel Club Rules, Ch. 11, Sec. 2. Entries not on an official entry form and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signature. Untitled entries for the TD or TDU Tests will not be accepted without a Certification issued within two years of the date of the test.

ENTRIES will be acknowledged with a judging program after the closing date. Should the exhibitor not receive such acknowledgment within a reasonable time, please notify the Test Secretary.

ENTRY FEES for alternates who don't participate in the test will be refunded within one week of the completion of the test. Entry fees for dogs which pass an AKC approved test after the closing date of this test will be refunded if they withdraw from this test, provided there is an alternative to replace the entry and the Test Secretary is notified in writing not less than 3 days before the test date. Bitches in season may participate (Ch. 2, Sec. 8). Other breeds, in addition to Golden Retrievers may participate (Ch.1, Sec. 13).

Judging: No exhibitor may show a dog under a judge at a tracking test if the exhibitor has participated in a training session taught by that judge within ten (10) days prior to the date of the event (Chapter 1, Sec. 12).

have boarded, laid a track for, or regularly trained the dogs whose tracks they are to lay. The tracklayer must not be a person with whom the dog has resided or a member of the household or a member of the immediate family of the dog's handler (Chapter 2, Sec. 9).

Combined Test Exchange: This test will be held under the combined test exchange policy (AKC Tracking Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 13a). The exchange policy will be in effect with the available tracks being filled first with untitled dogs followed by titled dogs. If the limit for entries is not reached in one test at a combined TD-TDX or TDU-VST test and the limit for entries is exceeded in the other test, the number of tracks may be exchanged, up to the day of plotting.

Workers' Draw: 1 track will be allocated in the TDX. A Workers Draw Certificate must accompany the entry (Ch1, Sec. 17d).

Trophies: Each dog passing the Test will receive the last article and an additional appropriate award donated by MBGRC.

Directions to test headquarters: Pardee's Farm, Spencerfield Farm, 12565 Spring Arbor Rd., Concord, MI 49237

From East or West on I-94: Take exit #136, (M-60 South). Go thru the city of Spring Arbor. Approximately 4 miles, Pardee's farm is on the left, **Event Headquarters for all events.** If coming from the southwest, take I-69 to M-60 (Exit 25) and go east (left). Pardee's farm is past Concord on the right, 12565 Spring Arbor Rd., Concord, MI 49237. Tracking flags will be placed at the end of the driveway to help find the entrance to the farm.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner and/or leasee of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury, or damage to this dog. INSTRUCTIONS

(Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in., but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

(Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
